The end of the school year is fast approaching, so please make sure you pay promptly for all the dinners your child has had this term. Thank you.

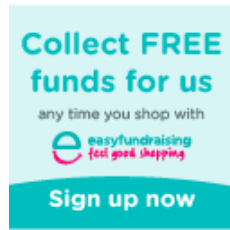
### Disabled Parking Bays
