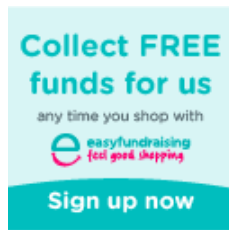

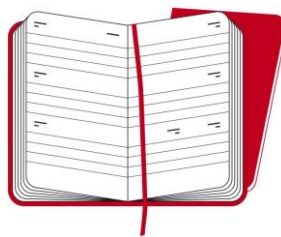


It works in a similar way to many other loyalty shopping sites, but instead of earning points when you shop, you raise a donation for Moor Hey School. It's as simple as that!
