Additional Car Parking spaces

As many people will have seen we have extended the car parking facilities at the front of school during the summer break.

The car park to the left of the entrance gates as you enter school is allocated for staff (furthest section is restricted to staff only as part of the planning permission conditions) which means that parents and visitors have more space to the right of the school entrance.

We have defined a specific drop off point for taxis in front of the basketball area so that children only have a short safe walk to the playground. Staff and visitors are asked not to park in this area as we now have close to 20 vehicles on site at the start and end of the day. Some of the vehicles access school from the back gate but we are trying to ensure pupil safety when coming into and leaving school.

We will also soon be adding a third minibus to the school transport collection (which is wheelchair accessible) and therefore we have marked out a school bus area alongside the main entrance. Please support us in ensuring access to this area is maintained at all times.
