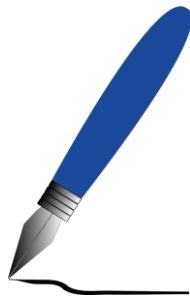

Weather permitting, Sports day will take place next week on Monday 13th July. Family and friends are welcome to come along and watch from 1.15pm.

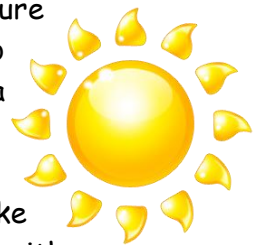
Summer Holiday Club


