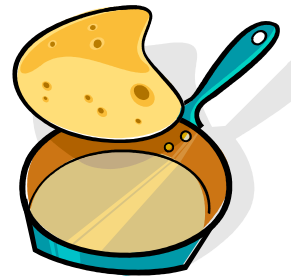
Nail Varnish

Pupils in Year 11 are able to have a school locker at a cost of £3. The payment will be given back at the end of the school year if the locker key is returned.

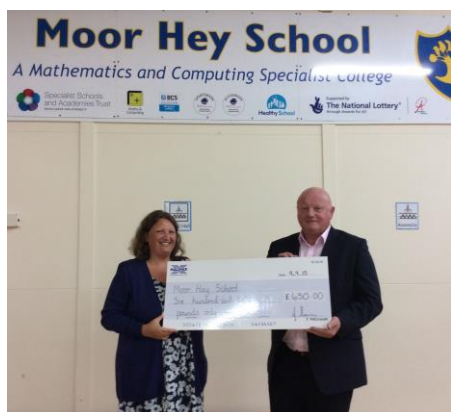
U-NITE Coffee Afternoon


The latest Scholastic book club leaflet has been sent home. If you would like to order some books, please return the order form, with the appropriate payment made out to Scholastic, as soon as possible.
