Thank you to everyone who came along and supported the Coffee morning. Through this and the cake sale we have raised more money towards the Residential trip. Thank you.

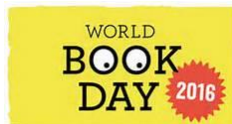


Jenga Tournament

We would appreciate your support and understanding in this matter.

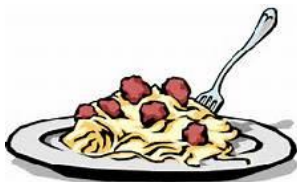
Year 9 DT

If your child does not usually have school dinners, but would like to have these special lunches, please contact the school office.

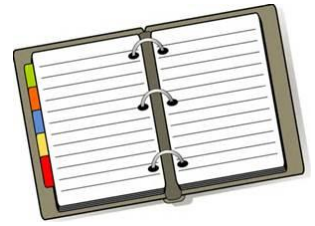
Easter Holiday Club

Easter holiday - school closes at the end of the school day on Friday 8th April and re-opens on Monday 25th April.


