## Medicines in School

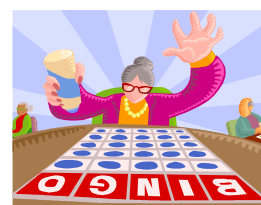

### College Open Evenings


**All Year 11 pupils and families** are invited to attend college open evenings as follows:
