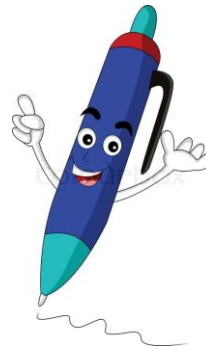

tags 50p. Pupils will be able

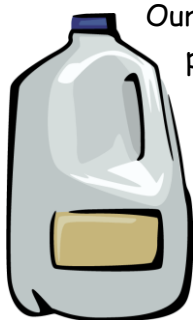
to buy items during form
