Please don't forget to reserve a place for your child if they would like to come long to the Easter Holiday Club. Places are filling up quickly!

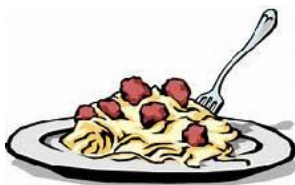
Special Lunches


