The Jenga competition raised £49.00 for the School Council. Thank you for your support.

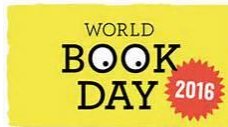
The coffee morning and cake sale raised a further £172.61 for the residential trip. Thank you for your generosity.

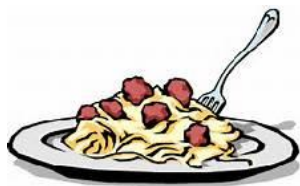
