Mrs. Marland is going to hold a coffee afternoon on **Wednesday 25th March** at 1.30pm - 3.30pm to raise funds for the residential trip.

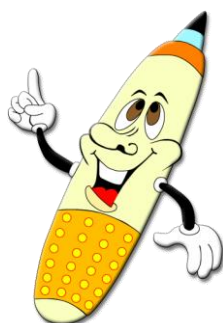


There will be a raffle with some great prizes. We would welcome donations of cakes - homemade or shop bought - on that day. Thank you.
