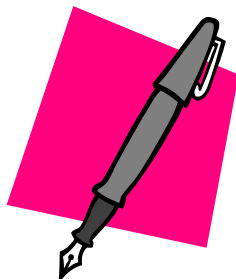
WORLD CUP 2014

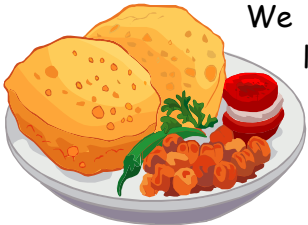
U-NITE Football Bonanza


