We break up today for half-term and return to school on Monday 7th November. Please remember to turn your clocks back by one hour on the night of Saturday 29th October.

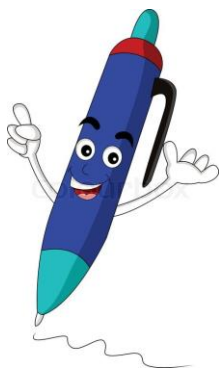
Farewell to Mr Mason


