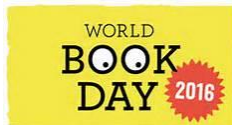

Between now and 8th July 2016 we are collecting these vouchers. If you shop in Sainsbury's, please make

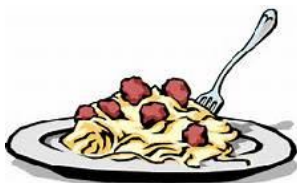
sure you collect the vouchers, then send them into school.

Easter holiday - school closes at the end of the school day on Friday 8th April and re-opens on Monday 25th April.


