Jenga Tournament



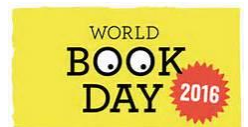
Due to the extraordinary success of School Council's Jenga tournament last year, coming on Thursday February 11th is: JENGA II.

We can then exchange them for sports and cooking equipment for our children. Thank you.

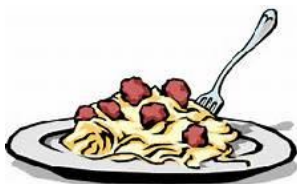
Year 9 DT


